Works Update – 19th December 2024

- Work is continuing in Area A5/A6 Athlunkard Boat Club. This area will be made secure, and sandbags will be in place for the Christmas Shutdown. On return in January, work will commence on the foul sewer diversion
- Permanent fencing is almost complete for Phase One in **Area A3 St Mary's Park**. On return after the Christmas Shutdown, work will commence on the storm sewer and fencing will continue towards the Handball alley, with the Fisherman's access to be maintained.
- Area B3 Courthouse King Johns Castle: Permanent fencing has commenced. This area will be closed to the public until further notice. On return in January, Archaeological testing will begin.


