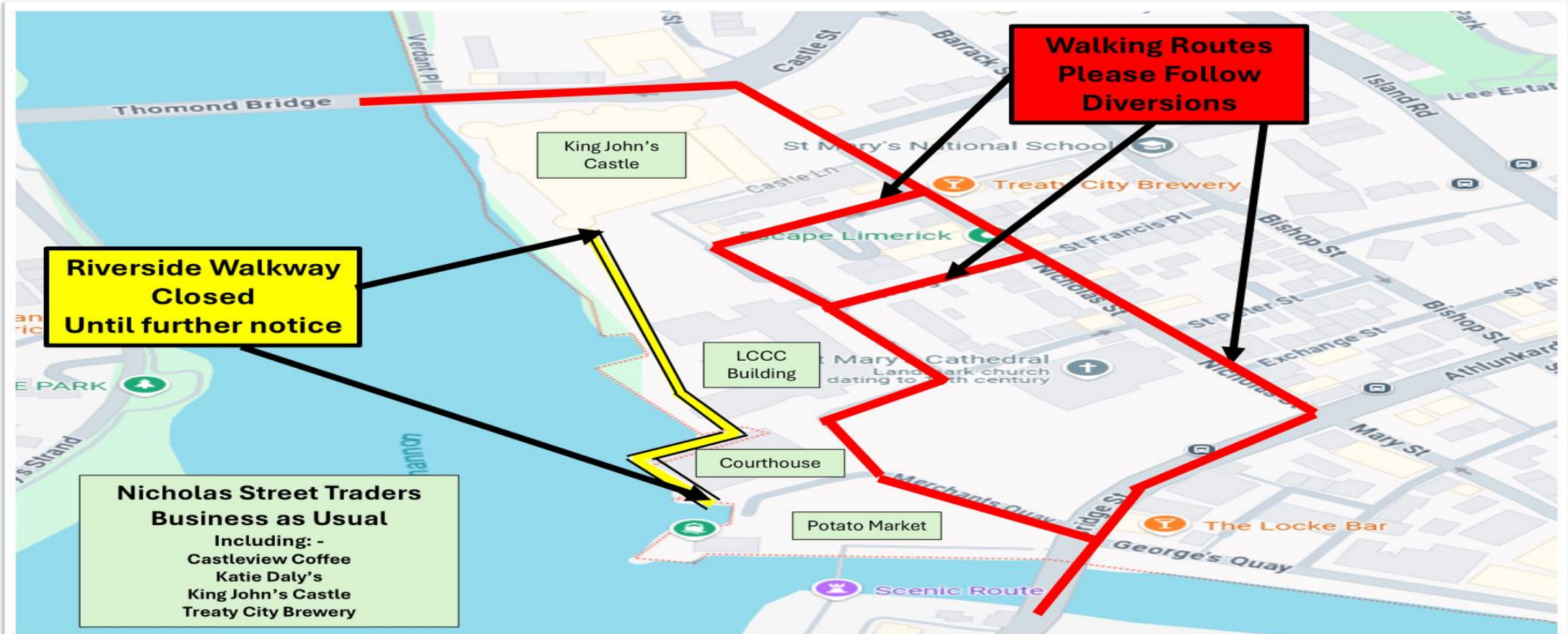
Works Update – 9th December 2024

- Work is continuing in **Area A5/A6** – Athlunkard Boat Club, fencing and site compound construction, and preparation for ESB Diversions
- Fencing and site compound set up has commenced in **Area A3** – St Mary's Park
- Temporary Fencing Work is completed in **Area B3** – Courthouse – King Johns Castle, with permanent fencing commencing this week
- **The Riverside Walkway** is now closed from the corner of the courthouse to the castle. We would ask that pedestrians please follow diversion signage for the 3 Bridges Walk. *Please see map attached*
