

#### Works Update – 26<sup>th</sup> February 2025

- **Area A2** Work is progressing well with the installation of the concrete piles now complete. Temporary flood defenses in place
- Area A3 St Mary's Park Site Work is progressing well on foul sewer diversion and the haul road is almost completed. Work is progressing on the outfall with temporary flood defenses in place
- Area A5/A6 Lee Estate Site The foul sewer works are continuing, with the tie in now almost completed at Athlunkard Villa FC. Along with temporary flood defenses put in place

There will be **Traffic Management** on the road at Lee Estate over the coming week or so. We would like to apologise for any inconvenience caused to residents in Lee Estate and Abbey View. The Road Sweeper will be on site every evening to ensure the road is kept clean.






#### Works Update – 26<sup>th</sup> February 2025

- Area B3 Courthouse King Johns Castle, work is progressing well, with the remainder of the hoarding to be completed this week. Directional signs in place, with more to come in the coming weeks to ensure people know where to go, now that the Riverside section of the walk is closed for the duration of the project.
- Area A7 Sir Harry's Mall. We are currently working on plans for Traffic Management, flood protection and parking for residents in this area prior to works which are due to commence mid-March.

In preparation for these works, Ward & Burke invited the emergency services to site. We even had the Fire Tender on site!! The Fire Chief was very happy that there will not be any issues with access in the case of an emergency in vicinity of St Francis Abbey/Sir Harrys Mall. Once the road closure is in place, they will run drills in the area to familiarise their teams with the new traffic layouts.


